

Supplement Table 1: Endoleak Definitions	
Type 1 Endoleak	Persistent filling of aneurysm due to inadequate seal between graft and vessel wall at the proximal (1a) or distal (1b) end of the stent graft.
Type 2 Endoleak	Filling of aneurysm sac due to retrograde flow from collateral aortic branch vessels
Type 3 Endoleak	Persistent filling of aneurysm through graft components via either module disconnections (3a) or fabric disruption (3b).
Type 4 Endoleak	Filling of aneurysm sac due to porosity of graft material.
Type 5 Endoleak	Endotension - expansion of aneurysm sac without clear endoleak source.
Indeterminate	Unable to determine type of endoleak
